

PGA WEST MEMBERS ASSOCIATION MISSION STATEMENT

The PGA West Members Association is a nonprofit California corporation whose objectives, according to its bylaws, are to:

“Promote and encourage golf, tennis and other athletic sports; to promote and encourage the sport, pleasure, exercise and recreation of its members; to promote sociability and friendship among its members; and to manage and conduct entertainments, excursions, and social meetings of its members and to advance the cause of physical education and to establish a mutually beneficial relationship among its members.”

During its existence and as a direct result of attempting to purchase PGA West and all of its facilities from the Resolution Trust Corporation, a document, The Club Usage Agreement, was negotiated by and between the Association and KSL whereby the members of PGA West were afforded certain contractual benefits which were not otherwise available to them.

The Association realizes that the new Advisory Board elected by the members will not be funded and will not have any means of enforcing the Club Usage Agreement should any of its provisions be violated by KSL. Although the Advisory Board is charged with the responsibility of voting on modifications of the Agreement it will not have the means of direct communication with the members other than through KSL published media.

The Association realizes that many of the members of the Advisory Board have not been involved in any dealings with KSL and are not knowledgeable of the posture of KSL in relation with the members and it is the Association's position to share any such information with the Advisory Board.

Therefore the mission of the PGA West Members Association is to:

“Continue to provide communication to all members as to negotiations with KSL through cooperation with the Advisory Board, Residential Homeowners Association 1 and Residential Homeowners Association 2; furthermore to organize committees to help maintain and promote the physical and social facilities of the Club through a relationship with KSL for the benefit of all members and homeowners; to monitor the Club Usage Agreement and attempt to position the members to be the only buyer of The Club at PGA West should KSL decide to sell; to work with the Advisory Board so that its relationship with KSL will be as strong as is possible.”

In summary, our objective is to promote a relationship among all of the members to make PGA West the best possible facility for everyone who is privileged to enjoy this special place.
